- It must be written in good English.
- Each thesis should include a foreword by the supervisor outlining the significance
 of its content.
- The thesis should have a clearly defined structure with an introduction accessible to scientists not expert in the field.
- If the thesis includes previously published material, permission to reproduce this must be gained from the respective copyright holder.
- The thesis must have been examined and passed during the 12 months prior to nomination.
